- Assistance with Medicaid, Women Infant and Children's Program (WIC), and other assistance agencies.
- Access to social work support and resources
- Specialized mental health services
- Nutrition and breastfeeding support by a Registered Dietitian.
- Educational topics covered: Birth Control, Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS), Shaken Baby Syndrome, and Car Seats
- Connection with agencies who provide baby supplies
- Offer virtual classes including Labor and Delivery, Newborn Care and Breastfeeding
